

HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY

The High School Equivalency Diploma program provides persons who have not completed high school with an opportunity to demonstrate the attainment of developed abilities normally acquired through completion of a high school program of study. "Students can take HSE Exam through Pearson Vue GED or ETH HiSet (paper-based test)."

Classes are located throughout Johnston County during day and evening hours.

Successful completion of the state approved standardized credentialing exams is recognized by award of a High School Equivalency Diploma credential by the North Carolina Community College System.

This achievement is generally recognized as meeting educational requirements for employment or entrance into programs of higher education.

There is no cost to the individual for preparation classes; however, there are fees to take the official standardized exams.
